Faculty	Criteria
British Columbia	All UBC Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences members eligible to vote at our monthly Faculty Advisory Council meeting will be considered eligible for AFPC membership.
Alberta	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Faculty-paid academic staff members (both tenure track and non-tenure track, and APO with duties relating directly to the education of student pharmacists (e.g. teaching, experiential, etc.)) appointed at 0.5 FTE or greater. • Faculty paid appointments of less than 0.5 FTE but greater than 0.25 FTE if these activities are deemed by the Pharmacy Leadership Council integral to the delivery of the pharmacy program.
Saskatchewan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All tenured and tenure track faculty • All ASPA personnel with instructional appointments (these are our lab instructors for instance, who are not included in our faculty union nor are they tenure-track) • All continuing sessional instructor personnel • Must be at least 0.4FTE.
Manitoba	All Faculty-paid academic staff (tenured, tenure track and non-tenure track) at FTE 0.5 or higher.
Waterloo	Tenured or tenure track faculty and lecturers holding rank in the professorial stream in the School and instructors from the teaching staff and part-time teaching faculty, having a 40% or greater FTE appointment in the School will be eligible for membership in the Association of Faculties of Pharmacy of Canada.
Toronto	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All academic staff members (tenure track, teaching track, contract limited teaching appointments) with full or part-time appointments at the Faculty. • All Status-only faculty members • All Adjunct Lecturer and Adjunct Professor faculty members • All Program Directors with membership in Faculty Council
Montreal	Professors (assistant, associate and full), Clinical professors (assistant, associate and full).
Laval	<p>1) Professors (adjoint incl. sous-octroi, agrégés, titulaires et émérites) (i.e. assistant, associate, full and emeritus)</p> <p>2) Clinical professors (agrégé et titulaire)(i.e. associate and full)</p> <p>3) Charges de cours et d'enseignement et responsables de formation pratique qui ont un contrat d'au moins 3 ans.</p>
Dalhousie	Members must have a full or part time appointment at the College of Pharmacy and must be involved in teaching students, research or administration.
Memorial	Individuals meeting one of the following criteria are deemed to be members of AFPC: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All tenured faculty members 2. All tenure track faculty members 3. All persons holding a contractual appointment with a minimum three year term 4. All Clinical Assistant Professors 5. Structured Practice Experience Coordinator 6. Post-Doctoral Fellows
