Assistant or Associate Professor, Tenure-Track Appointment

The College of Pharmacy, Rady Faculty of Health Sciences, University of Manitoba, Canada invites applications for a tenure track position at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor, in any of the following areas: Pharmacoepidemiology, Pharmacoeconomics, Biostatistics, or Health Services & Delivery

Applicants must possess a Ph.D., preferably with post-doctoral training, OR a clinical degree in the Health Sciences (i.e. post-baccalaureate PharmD or MD) with a thesis-based M.Sc., fellowship training, or otherwise demonstrated research experience. Relevant experience is required. The successful candidate will be expected to develop and maintain an independent externally-funded research program, (e.g., through Canadian Tri-Council Agencies). The applicant will be expected to teach in the undergraduate and graduate programs, and to provide service to the College of Pharmacy and the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences. Salary and rank will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

The College of Pharmacy is located in a state-of-the-art 90 000 sq. feet Apotex Centre on the Bannatyne Campus at the University of Manitoba. There are significant opportunities for collaboration within Pharmacy and other Health Science Colleges. The Manitoba Centre for Health Policy (MCHP), in the Max Rady College of Medicine, provides access to a world-class population-based research unit, with a rich data repository, that includes person-level health, pharmaceutical and social services data of the entire population of Manitoba. The MCHP is a site of the Canadian Network for Observational Drug Effect Studies (CNODES) to which members of the College of Pharmacy maintain formal affiliation and close collaboration. The Vaccine and Drug Evaluation Centre, part of the Department of Community Health Sciences, is housed in the Apotex Centre and offers unique research opportunities.
