



## MIDPOINT ASSESSMENT Rationale • Previously: 2 summative non-course based evaluations in year four (OSCE, rotations) • Struggling students identified; limited remediation time Midpoint Assessment: 2 parts • Minimum competency assessment; does not affect progression • 100 question MCQ • 5 station OSCE • Objectives: ID students who do not demonstrate minimum competency expected of student at end of 2<sup>nd</sup> year



## **CONCLUSIONS**
