

The College of Pharmacy and Nutrition invites applications from qualified individuals for a full time, tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor in the Pharmacy program. The successful candidate will focus on the areas of infectious diseases, and/or general medicine (adult or pediatrics), with interprofessional practice. The candidate will integrate several activities into their focus area including undergraduate teaching, clinical activities, graduate student supervision, research and/or scholarly work. Administrative activities will be expected after the candidate has been given time to establish their primary focus areas. The candidate needs to establish and maintain clinical practice.

The University of Saskatchewan's main campus is situated on Treaty 6 Territory and the Homeland of the Métis. The University of Saskatchewan is located in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, a city with a diverse and thriving economic base, a vibrant arts community and a full range of leisure opportunities. ### **Qualifications**

A post-baccalaureate PharmD or Ph.D. is required. The candidate must be licensed or eligible for licensure in Saskatchewan by the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacy Professionals; licensure must be obtained within 6 months of the appointment date. Experience in the clinical areas of infectious diseases, and/or general medicine (adult or pediatrics), with interprofessional practice is required. We seek a candidate who has effective teaching, interpersonal, and communication skills. Candidates should also have a strong interest and ability to engage in research and scholarly activities. Hospital residency or post-graduate fellowship training will be considered an asset.

Salary bands for this position are as follows: Assistant Professor: \$98,178 to \$117,978; and Associate Professor: \$117,978 to \$137,778. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. This position includes a comprehensive benefits package which includes a dental, and extended health and vision care plan; pension plan, life insurance (compulsory and voluntary), academic long-term disability, sick leave, travel insurance, death benefits, an employee assistance program, a professional expense allowance, and a flexible health and wellness spending program. Other benefits include optional accidental death & dismemberment (ad&d) insurance, tuition waivers, scholarship fund for immediate family members, housing assistance, moving expenses, sabbatical travel expenses, and research grant in lieu of salary.

Review of applications will begin March 20, 2023; however, applications will be accepted and evaluated until the position is filled. The desired start date is July 1, 2023.
